Our School

370 students were enrolled in the 2019 school year, 188 female and 182 male, and this is expected to increase to 390 in 2020.

We have an enthusiastic and professional staff team and the school has a strong focus on teacher/staff development. The staffing profile is made up of 1 principal, 1 assistant principal, 1 acting learning specialist teacher, 23 teachers (20.2 EFT), 6 education support staff (3.9 EFT), and a business manager.

Overview

In 2019, thanks to the consistent focus of the teachers and school leadership NPS had some fantastic improvements across the board in both learning and wellbeing outcomes for students.

- Learning results are measured through the NAPLAN testing for year 3 and 5 students along with teacher judgements.
- Student wellbeing is measured through the 'Attitudes to School Survey' completed by all Victorian school students annually.


Reading the results:




