Our students' attitudes to school results also reflect a very healthy and positive sense of connectedness, which sits above the median of Victorian schools' results.

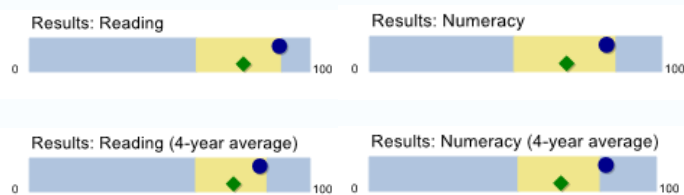
- Learning results are measured through the NAPLAN testing for year 3 and 5 students along with teacher judgements.

Reading the results:

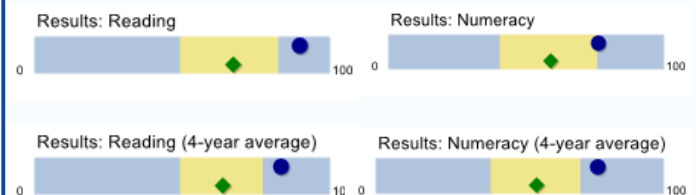
- The blue spots indicate our school's result.

NAPLAN Year 3

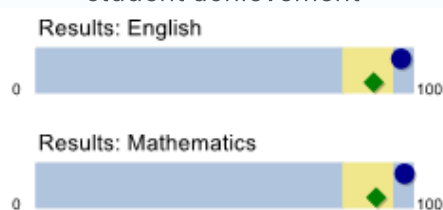


NAPLAN Year 5
